12 presentations on sediment transport issues approaching several topics related to:

contaminated sediments remobilization, reliability and performance of sediment transport models, separation and valorization of sediments from sludge, field experiments in coastal areas, erosion processes in rivers, analytical developments and numerical modelling and transport of large-scale objects by tsunamis.

The presentations were originated both from **universities** and **private companies** (1/3).

These included however, and in equivalent amounts, **practical** applications and fundamental research.



We had a good balance between presentations devoted to practical applications and others to more fundamental aspects of sediment transport issues.
